

**Runners at the Eisenhower Marathon and Half Marathon wind through the territory south of Abilene that cattlemen followed when bringing their herds to Abilene on the Chisholm Trail in the 1800s.**

**All paved course, mostly flat and fast, USATF sanctioned and certified, code #KSO 2046BG, 2012 Boston Marathon Qualifier.**

**Race begins and ends at the Eisenhower Presidential Center. Marathon/Half start 7a.m. on April 9, 2011, (7:30 a.m. for 10K/5K; 9 a.m. for Walk). Traffic detoured 7a.m.-1p.m.**

## RACE INFORMATION

**MARATHON:** \$500 for 1<sup>st</sup> overall (both for men and for women)  
\$300 for 2<sup>nd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)  
\$200 for 3<sup>rd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

*All marathon finishers receive finishers medals.*

Additional 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals given to both men and women in each age group.

ENTRY FEE: \$75, (late registration after March 1, \$85)

**HALF-MARATHON:** \$150 for 1<sup>st</sup> overall (both for men and for women)  
\$100 for 2<sup>nd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)  
\$ 75 for 3<sup>rd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

*All half-marathon finishers receive finisher medals.*

Medals to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place (both men and women) all age groups.

ENTRY FEE: \$45, (late registration after March 1, \$55)

**10K:** \$30 (\$40 late), **5K:** \$25 (\$35 late), **Community Walk:** \$20

*Medals to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, (both men and women in each age group), both 10K & 5K.*

*All receive Eisenhower Marathon ribbons, including Community Walkers).*

**AGE GROUPS:** 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70+ (parent's permission required for runners under 18)

*Youth under age 10 are ineligible to run the marathon, half, 10K and 5K.*

*Youth 10-14 years old are eligible for 5K/10K races only.*

*Middle and high school runners should check with athletic directors before entering.*

**MEDICAL STAFF** at Start/Finish, Marathon Turnaround, Brown Memorial Park, and at intersection of 1600 Ave. and Hwy 15

**AID STATIONS** approximately every mile with fruit, Powerade and water.

**PORT-A-POTTIES** or **RESTROOMS**, approximately every three miles.
