(USATF sanctioned and certified-code #KS02046BG, mostly flat and fast)

**MARATHON:** \$500 for 1<sup>st</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

\$300 for 2<sup>nd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

\$200 for 3<sup>rd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

*All marathon finishers receive finishers medals*

Additional 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals given to both men and women in each age group.

ENTRY FEE: \$70, (late registration after March 1, \$75)\*\*

**HALF-MARATHON:** \$150 for 1<sup>st</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

\$100 for 2<sup>nd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

\$75 for 3<sup>rd</sup> overall (both for men and for women)

*All half-marathon finishers receive medals*

Medals to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place (both men and women) all age groups.
